

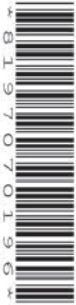

Explain how the design was used in this study.

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(ii) Outline **two** weaknesses of using an independent measures design in this study.

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4 (a) (i) Give **two** features of the sample used in Bandura *et al.*'s (1961) study into aggression.

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(ii) Outline **one** way in which this sample was biased.

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(b) Kohlberg's (1968) study of moral development raises a number of issues of validity. Describe **two** issues of validity in this study.

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5 (a) Explain how Milgram's (1963) study into obedience can be related to the social area.

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(b) Explain the extent to which Bocchiaro *et al.*'s (2012) study into disobedience changes our understanding of individual, social and cultural diversity.
